Workshops



Circus skills and play are used as tools to promote healthy activities, co-operation and self-esteem while providing a much-needed opportunity for fun and laughter.

Accessibility, inclusion and gender equality are key elements in our project delivery.

Methods have been tested and developed over several years of dry season social circus workshops in Yangon led by Jules Howarth, Social Circus Myanmar, who is project manager of the Circus Play Project (CPP).

Participants learn a new, sustainable set of skills and have an experience in which they:

- Learn how to learn
- Practise sharing skills
- · Play and work with each other as equals
